Isabelle Marie Krug - 52 years of Dedication

A quote was once read to me in a recently attended church service that stated; “The only thing you can take to heaven with you, is your children”. How true a statement! The true understanding of this statement leads me to introduce you to Isabelle Krug. Isabelle Krug is an 84 year old model of what true dedication to the Lord looks like.

Isabelle Krug attended WLA in 1938/39. As a sophomore, during the depression, she had to leave WLA in order to clean houses to make money for her family. Isabelle met her late husband Carlton Krug, and resided in Town of Empire where the two of them were lifelong members to St. Pauls Lutheran Church town Forest. Together they raised seven children, Daryl (Class of ‘65) Colleen (Class of ‘70) Randal (Class of ‘73) Dennis (Class of ‘74) Carolyn (Class of ‘79) Eileen (Class of ‘80) and Wendy (Class of ‘84) and put them all through Winnebago Lutheran Academy. Carlton and Isabelle lost Randal in 1973 shortly after graduation due to an automobile accident, he was 18 years old.

Carlton and Isabelle believed the words from Proverbs 22 that stated “Train a Child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not turn from it”. God never fails on His promises! Today Isabelle is the Mother and Grandmother of 20 Winnebago Lutheran Academy graduates and 6 attending students. That accounts for 52 years (1961-2013) of dedication to Winnebago Lutheran Academy and its ongoing Christian education. Carlton and Isabelle continued to see their dedication to the Lord through the lives of their children who sent 19 of their own children.

A MESSAGE FROM OUR NEW BAND DIRECTOR, MARK STUEDEMANN

It feels like I'm coming back home. WLA obviously does make a difference in a student's life, especially this one. As I look back, it is plain to see the ramifications of God's work through the past, and in allowing me to be a part of the WLA family today. I attended Christ Lutheran School in Big Bend Wisconsin along with the Witte family. In 1976 we moved to Van Dyne were my twin brother, Robert, and I went to Grace in Oshkosh our eighth grade year. Randy Westphal was the Principal at the time and invited Robert and I to play trumpets in the Church service. We have been playing in the service of our Lord ever since and still do today. The following years were spent at WLA were I graduated in eighty-one. Since then I have stayed in the Fond du lac, Oshkosh, and Neenah areas. I married my identical twins' wife's' sister. I hope you were able to follow that. We have been singing as "The Lutheran Chamber Chorale" for over twenty years, and with our children the group has expanded from four to twelve.
