

WLA Hot Lunch / Ala Carte Overview

WLA offers Hot Lunch and Ala Carte items daily. Students also have the option of bringing their own bag lunch. Microwaves available for use in the cafeteria.

Hot Lunch Meal: \$3.90 per meal. This is considered a balanced meal with a main entrée, fruit, vegetables, dessert, and milk. Served daily at lunch in the cafeteria.


Ala Carte Items: Vary by price. Includes snacks, some hot food, and drinks such as juice, water, tea, etc. Served over morning break and during lunch in both the cafeteria and the east mezzanine.

WLA is not on the Federal Lunch Program but has an in-house reduced lunch program. The reduced lunch price is \$2.35 per meal. The application (which includes the income criteria) is available on the WLA website (under Latest Announcements) or by paper in the WLA office. The reduced lunch discount applies only to a Hot Lunch Meal. There is no reduced lunch discount for Ala Carte items.

1. Any funds a student/family had left from last year automatically carry over to the 2022-23 school year.
2. All students will have a student ID, printed on their student ID is a barcode and a lunch ID number. When a student deposits funds or makes a purchase, their student ID is scanned and their account is added to or subtracted from accordingly.
3. Funds can be deposited into a student's lunch account by cash or check in the office before school, after school, or at morning break. **Families can also deposit funds to their student's lunch account by ACH from a checking or savings account or by credit/debit card.** There is no extra charge for an ACH deposit but there is a 3% convenience fee for any credit/debit card deposit.
4. Lunch accounts are family based and not student based. This means if a family has multiple students at WLA, the family has one family balance, rather than having separate balances for their individual students.


Steps to view lunch account and make ACH/Credit Card deposits.

1. To electronically deposit funds to your lunch account – you need to be logged into your family's Powerschool account via the Powerschool website <https://wels.powerschool.com/public/>. It will NOT work if you try to access your lunch account through the Powerschool app.
2. Log into your Powerschool Parent account and click on WLA food service on the left side of the screen.




- The next screen shows your family's account. For Student Settings, if you wish, you can limit how much your student spends in a day. Note that WLA does not have breakfast. Be aware that any items purchased during morning break or during lunch count toward that lunch total. The default setting is \$50 (no student gets close to spending this much in a day). The bottom of the screen shows family transactions which includes deposits and purchases. Ala Carte purchases are broken down by item.

If you wish to make an ACH or Credit/debit Card deposit click on the orange fork and knife at the top of the page.




- On the Food Service Screen you can add funds via ACH or Credit card by clicking “Add Funds” in the middle of the page.

If you wish to apply for reduced lunch – click on the purple icon in the middle of the page.



- After clicking “Add Funds” it brings you to the following page. Under “Add Balance to Family” enter the amount you would like to add. After entering the amount, click on “Pay Now”.



- The first time you add funds to your family’s account, you need to set up your funding source. Once this is set up, it will default to the funding source you have set up.
